

# **Braided Funding**





# What is braided funding?

- The coordination of funding from several sources to support a single initiative, or a portfolio of projects or programs
- Each funding source preserves its distinction so that each funder can still track resources and outcomes.
- Funding streams supplement one another; funds can be used at the same time, but for unique expenses.



# Why braid funding?

- Aligns partners/programs toward common outcomes.
- Improves outcomes for your clients by connecting them to deeper or more diverse resources.
- More fully leverages all resources available in a jurisdiction
- Reduces fragmentation, overlap and duplication across funding types
- Reduces administrative burden in favor of better service delivery
- Stabilizes funding across cycles



# What to look for ?

Serving the same or similar population

Offer the same, similar or complementary services

Similar regulations or flexibility in regulation

If your agency currently has more than one funding source, you are likely already braiding funds!

# At the client level – simple version

Project Room Key (one month)

John needs immediate motel placement and is

He is placed in a motel and enrolled in PRK

After three weeks in his hotel placement, a deeper assessment identifies that John is a good candidate for HDAP program.

HDAP (24 months)

John is enrolled in HDAP program. Benefits advocacy, housing navigation, and financial assistance are provided.

Early on, the case management team submits applications to connect John to a "mainstream" Section 8 Affordable housing voucher.

After 6 months of housing location support, an apartment is located that is a good fit for John. Move in and ongoing rent subsidy support is provided by HDAP funds while benefits advocacy continues.

Eventually, John is matched to a Section 8 voucher via the CoC.

Section 8 Affordable Housing Voucher (Permanent Resource)

John is able to use his Section 8 voucher in the unit he already lives in that was originally supported with HDAP funds. HDAP housing case management and housing navigators support John and his landlord during the transition to a Section 8 voucher.

After successfully being connected to SSDI benefits, John pays 30% of his income towards rent.

(through 2027 -- but clients will have intermittent and one time eligibility for various services)
